5 Things to Know about the Peace Corps Community in Michigan

Historically, Michigan ranks 12th in the nation in sending volunteers abroad to serve in the Peace Corps. The University of Michigan ranks 5th in the nation historically in recruiting Peace Corps volunteers, while Michigan State ranks 6th.

Peace Corps has educational partnerships with four Michigan institutions: Eastern Michigan University, Michigan State University, Michigan Tech, and the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor.

National Peace Corps Association affiliate groups include the Southeastern Michigan Returned Peace Corps Volunteers (RPCVs), the RPCVs of West Michigan, the Southwestern Michigan RPCVs, and the RPCVs of North Michigan.

Charitable giving over the years by the Southeastern Michigan RPCVs has included supporting Peace Corps Volunteers in the field working on development projects in Albania, Ecuador, Ghana, Namibia, Senegal, and Togo.

2023 and early 2024 activities of the RPCVs of North Michigan include preparing dinners at the Safe Harbor homeless shelter in Traverse City, volunteering once a month at a book distribution center that sends books to students in 17 countries. They also sponsored two refugee families (Afghanistan and Ukraine) during the holidays, and volunteered at a MLK Day movie at a local theatre.
