5 Things to Know about the Peace Corps Community in Missouri

Peace Corps has educational partnerships with Truman State University, University of Central Missouri, Fontbonne University, Missouri State University-Springfield, University of Missouri-Columbia, and Washington University of St. Louis.

National Peace Corps Association affiliate groups include the St. Louis Peace Corps Association, the Central Missouri Returned Peace Corps Volunteers (RPCVs), and the Kansas City Peace Corps Association (KCPCA).

2024 KCPCA community service projects included volunteering with After the Harvest, which distributes rescued produce to people in need in northwest Missouri.

In September 2024, the University of Missouri featured Alex McCarty, a graduate from Lee's Summit and Panama Returned Peace Corps Volunteer, who teamed up with another grad to launch an online retail business that specializes in barbecue grills, gas and electric heaters, and outdoor cooking accessories.

Missouri native and University of Missouri graduate David Gressly has had a forty year career with the United Nations, with high profile roles in Yemen, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Mali, South Sudan, India, Guinea, and Nigeria. His career was launched when he served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Kenya.
