## 5 Things to Know about the Peace Corps Community in Wyoming

Among medium colleges and universities, the University of Wyoming has ranked in the top 25 in sending Peace Corps Volunteers overseas.

The University of Wyoming has an educational partnership with the Peace Corps. UW students have an opportunity to earn a Peace Corps certificate by taking selected courses, strengthening their opportunity to serve.

Michael Dixon, Historic Preservation Architect who oversaw the \$300 million restoration of the Wyoming State Capitol building, served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Ukraine (2011–14), Armenia (2015), and Kosovo (2016).

Naomi Martinez, who served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Peru from 2015-17, is the operations manager for the Laramie based company "Plenty", which is innovating agriculture by growing fresh produce vertically indoors with no pesticides and using less water.

Since 1975, sixteen Returned Peace Corps Volunteers or former Peace Corps staff – both Democrats and Republicans – have served in the United States Congress.
