Our Request:

- At the very least, continue to fund the Peace Corps in Fiscal Year 2026 at its present level (\$430.5 million).
- Please include robust funding for the Peace Corps in your personal appropriations request for Fiscal Year 2026.

Five Key Reasons to Support the Peace Corps:

- 1. **Service to Others:** Since 1961, a quarter million volunteers and staff have served in the Peace Corps in more than 140 nations. **Collectively, Peace Corps Volunteers** have provided well over one billion hours of service to our nation.
- 2. **So Much for So Little:** It is often forgotten that our entire international affairs spending amounts to <u>approximately one percent</u> of total federal spending. It is less known that the Peace Corps makes up <u>less than one percent</u> of international affairs spending.
- 3. **A Huge Return on Investment:** A 2023 survey of Returned Peace Corps Volunteers found that 86% of respondents remain active as volunteers in their communities here at home, well above the national average. Thousands of these volunteers serve in leadership roles, helping their communities thrive.
- 4. **Very Little Investment in the Past Decade:** Over the past decade (Since FY 2016), Congress has only provided the Peace Corps with a five percent increase in its baseline funding. During this period, the agency has already lost nearly 25 percent of its purchasing power.
- 5. **Bi-Partisan Support:** Over its 64 year history, the Peace Corps has experienced strong, bi-partisan support. Please make sure this support continues.
