AFFILIATE GROUP MATCHING GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

As part of National Peace Corps Association's (NPCAs) commitment to promote Peace Corps' Third Goal. NPCA will provide **up to 5 matching grants of \$500 to \$2000** per quarter (20 per calendar year) starting in 2025. The matching grants will support projects, activities or events that are hosted by RPCV affiliate groups in the following area:

- Local advocacy efforts related to Peace Corps
- Environmental and Climate Change action
- Refugee and migrant support
- DEI programs that promote inclusivity

The purpose of these grants is to provide financial support that promotes Peace Corps ideals and volunteerism, encourages US societal representation, stimulates regional and local advocacy efforts, and addresses the needs of communities that have benefited from volunteers in support of continuation of services. Funded projects will provide an opportunity for RPCV groups to market their activities and share ideas and practices that can be replicated.

Eligibility

- 1. The group must have completed the most recent NPCA re-affiliation survey (or be a group in its first year).
- 2. The project/activity/event must be used in the calendar year in which it is provided.
- 3. The project/activity/event for which the group request resources should be planned to reach a minimum of at least 25 people
- 4. The project/activity/event must contribute to the collective impact of NPCA in promoting Peace Corps ideals, in particular equity and inclusion
- 5. Application may be completed by any group member, but must be submitted by a member of the group's leadership (board of directors) on behalf of the group.

How to Apply

- 1. The completed application must be emailed to groups@peacecorpsconnect.org by the quarterly deadlines listed below
 - a. January 2, 2025
 - b. March 3, 2025
 - c. June 2, 2025
 - d. October 1, 2025
- 2. Complete and sign application form (page 2). Required.
- 3. Provide a description of the group and strategic priorities (page 3). Required.
- 4. Describe your project in two pages or less, (page 4). Required.
- 5. Provide a detailed budget (page 5), demonstrating group cash contributions. Required.
- 6. Add relevant documentation that supports the application, if desired. Optional.

Selection Criteria and Process

- Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:
 - How well the project/activity/event supports the Third Goal of the Peace Corps
 - The impact of the project/activity/event on the community served
 - The project/activity/event demonstrates/promotes NPCAs DEI values/principles

- Capacity to support Peace Corps recruitment efforts that result in more volunteers entering service
- Project/activity/event is scalable and can serve as a model or inspiration for other groups
- The NPCA Board Affiliate Group Committee will evaluate applications and notify groups about decisions within one month.
 - a. January 31, 2025
 - b. March 31, 2025
 - c. June 30, 2025
 - d. October 1, 2025
- Maximum of one grant per year per group
- Groups are welcome to apply each year, but priority will be given to groups who have not previously received support.
- Successful group applications will be posted on the NPCA website and completed projects highlighted in other media. .
