Continue your service journey at home

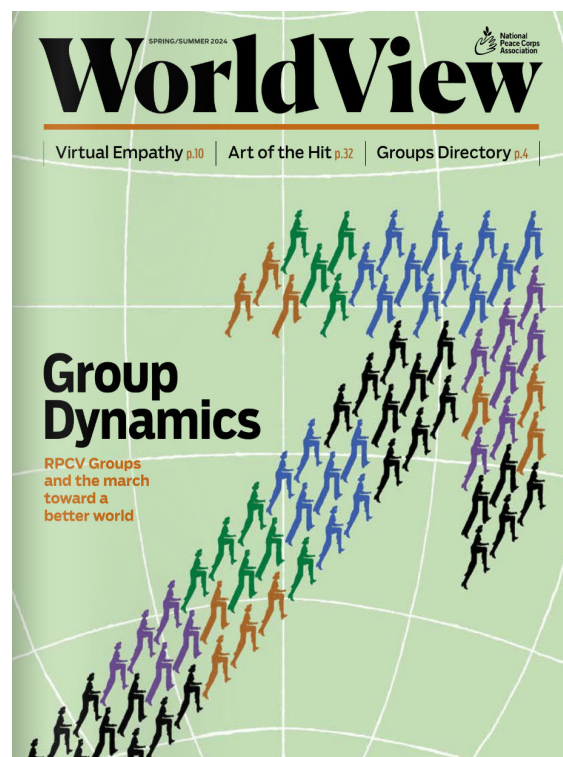
